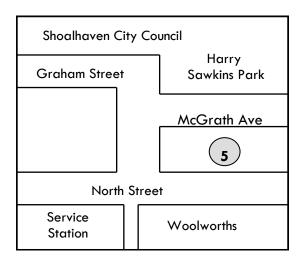

Services & Activities

Counselling

Counselling on a wide variety of issues including depression, anxiety, grief, sexual assault, stress, parenting, sexuality and relationships is available at the Centre

Herbal Medicine

This service may include iris diagnosis, herbal remedies, vitamin and mineral therapies, and information and advice on nutrition

Massage / Reiki

Therapeutic and remedial massage is available 2 days per week. Reiki is also available on request on a Tuesday. Massage helps relieve body aches and pains, may improve mobility and musculoskeletal function. Reiki (universal life energy) is a non intrusive method of hands on healing which may assist the body and mind to achieve a greater sense of well being

Meditation / Relaxation

Benefits of meditation/relaxation include increased confidence, self control, concentration, inner certainty and health. Meditation also increases the ability to focus and let go of negative emotions such as anger and anxiety as well as improving the posture. Please phone to find out when the next group begins

Women's Health Nurse

Each Tuesday, the Centre hosts a NSW Health Well Women's Clinic where women can access a range of services including pap smears; breast checks; diaphragm fitting; and education/information on a variety of issues including contraception, PMS, menopause, sexually transmitted infections and hormone replacement therapy

The Centre runs a range of day and half day workshops on a variety of topics including:
